Dear Dean,

I wish to advise that the Health Australia Party supports the following environmental policies.

We support as a minimum 40% renewable energy by 2025 and 50% by 2030 under Victorian Renewable Energy Target.

We wish solar panels and/or hot water systems to be available, where technically appropriate, on all new homes. We believe in helping renters, public housing tenants and apartment dwellers access solar and energy efficiency through discounted solar panels and solar hot water systems to low income families. And we would like to see solar panels and batteries in Victoria's public schools over the next 5 years

Finally, we strongly support the preservation of existing national parks and the establishment of new parks, in particular the Great Forest National Park. We believe that stronger laws are needed to protect nature in general - it is a limited and a precious resource.

Finally, we would like to implement pollution reduction programs against all harmful chemicals (e.g. glyphosate) and non-degradable materials (e.g. plastics) in the general environment.
