

Pocket guide for MP meetings



1. Tell the receptionist you are a local

constituent and you'd like to ask your MP a quick question about a policy decision that's coming up. Show your MP the sign you've printed out, and ask them:

Will you champion state climate targets in line with keeping global warming below 1.5 degrees?

2. Based on how the MP responds to this question, put a tick, cross or question mark in the box.

3. Ask the MP to take a photo with you and the sign. If they say no, take a photo with yourself, your group and the sign outside their office. Make sure you get the MP's name in the photo (it'll be written on the office window facing the street).

4. Email the photo to us -

5. If you are on social media, post the photo, tag your MP, use the hashtag #springst and write some personal thoughts about their position on strong targets.

6. If the MP isn't there, or won't meet with you, leave a "sorry we missed you" flyer, put a question mark in the box on the sign, and take the photo out the front of their office, with their name on the office window in the background.
