- Applications for the annual renewal, received by Wednesday 17 July 2024 will be processed for the 28 August 2024 renewal.
- Late applications received after 17 July, and by 31 October, will be processed by the end of November.

Upon inclusion in Environment Victoria's insurance policy the group will be invoiced, payable within 30 days. <u>Please do not pay any fees until an invoice has been received</u>. On receipt of payment a certificate of currency will be provided.
