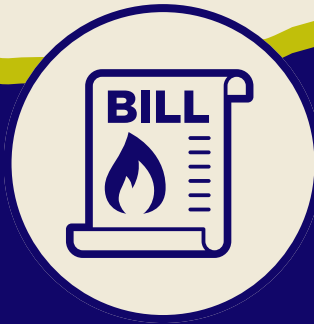


HOW WE MAKE SURE **EVERYONE** CAN ENJOY THE BENEFITS OF CLEAN ENERGY



Fund and expand existing programs to benefit renters and people who live in apartments

This includes the Solar Homes rebates, the Victorian Energy Upgrades (VEU) program, and battery incentives.



Deliver improvements to rental standards

From March 2027, rental homes must have efficient insulation, draught-proofing, and efficient electric heating and hot water. This will cut bills for renters, but the standards only commence after the election, which means every party must commit to seeing them through.



Commit to clear targets and effective incentives to encourage solar and electrification for apartments



Fix owners corporation rules

Sustainability upgrades in apartments currently require a 75% supermajority vote to proceed – this threshold should be lowered.



Make the Victorian Energy Upgrades (VEU) program work for apartments

The VEU program helped to encourage lighting upgrades in common areas. Now we need new initiatives designed for shared rooftop solar, electric vehicle charging, and heat-pump hot water.



Give people trapped in 'embedded networks' a choice

People in apartments with 'embedded networks' should have a choice of energy providers so they can access solar savings and escape bills for gas they're no longer using. This requires active intervention, not a gradual phase-out.
